

Choral Program “Get Fit Day” – Saturday, October 3rd

Get Fit Day is a **mandatory** fitting day to assign all performance garments for Chorale, Aria and Men’s Ensemble. All students in these choirs must be fitted for their garment on Saturday, October 3rd

Students must bring their completed choir emergency form, a completed handbook agreement form (if not yet turned in), a completed statement of financial responsibility, a completed garment check-out form (all of which can be found on uplandhighschoolchoir.org) along with a full or partial fair-share donation.

Students will not be given their garment to take home if these forms are not properly filled out and turned in with the fair-share donation.

The times for the fittings are as follows:

Chorale Men (A-L):	10:30-11:15
Choral Men (M-Z):	11:15-12:00
Chorale Ladies (A-L):	12:00-12:45
Choral Ladies (M-Z):	12:45-1:30
Aria (A-L):	1:30-2:15
Aria (L-Z):	2:15-3:00

Students should wear close fitting t-shirts/tank tops and work-out/P.E. style shorts that performance garments can be easily slipped over to check the fit.

CHORAL DEPARTMENT WARDROBE INFORMATION

Our goal is to help each student look and feel their absolute best when performing as part of the Upland High Choral Department and perform with the utmost poise and confidence. The following information and policies will help us reach this goal. Please contact the Choral Parent for your student's choir for performance garment questions.

Students in the Upland High School Choral Department are responsible for any and all wardrobe items (such as tuxedo, dress, costume, hanging bag etc.) issued to them at any time throughout the school year. This includes keeping items clean, pressed, and in good repair. Additionally, if an item is issued in a hanging bag, it is expected that these items will be kept in the hanging bag at all times when not being worn. All wardrobe items are checked out to students for the year and are to be returned immediately following the final performance. It is the student's responsibility to thoroughly inspect items issued to them at the time they are issued for any problems--once an item is checked out; it is the student's full responsibility to return it in the same condition. If any problems are noted at the time of issue, these should be noted in writing by the person issuing the item and kept on file. It is also advisable that each student inspects their wardrobe item(s) after each use for damage and report any found immediately. If any wardrobe item is lost, stolen, or damaged while issued to a student, the student will be held financially liable up to the following amounts:

For concert performances, students should have conservative hairstyles (all hair must be pulled back and out of the face area), and must be a natural human hair color. Girls should be very conservative with their make-up. Girls may wear one ring per hand, one bracelet per arm, and one set of 'non-dangling earrings.' No facial piercings are permitted during performances. Guys may wear one ring per hand, one bracelet per arm, may only wear stud earrings, and may not wear any facial piercing or make up. No one may wear visible necklaces.

Expressions Jazz Choir will determine their own costume requirements during the fall.

Students will be charged for all garments not returned by the deadline. Students who owe balances due to failure to return borrowed garments at the end of the school year may have final grades held, and may not be allowed to register for future classes or graduate until the balances are paid.
